

LETTERS TO THE EDITOR POLICY

Letters to the Editor must include the writer's full name. Anonymous letters and letters written under pseudonyms will not be considered.

For verification purposes, they must also include a valid CDIB number, writer's home address, email address and phone number.

Letters may be edited by our staff for grammar, length and clarity.

We will NOT print letters that:

- Contain potentially libelous material. Libel is any malicious, unsubstantiated, or untrue statement about someone that damages their reputation. Submissions must have facts to back up all claims.
- Support discrimination on any grounds. This includes, but is not limited to, discrimination based on age, ability, gender, sexual orientation, religion, or culture.
- Are vulgar, profane, obscene, derogatory, or otherwise offensive.
- Make explicit or implied threats. This includes personal attacks, intimidation, bullying, or threat of harm against a person or organization.
- Contain copyrighted material or that have been printed in another publication.
- Contain language or content that is blatantly offensive, or that the editor feels is inappropriate.
